

OneGoal Equipment "Loan Out" Program



KAHA has taken advantage of a program sweeping North America. We, along with 100's of other hockey associations, have purchased sets of starter equipment from OneGoal, to "loan out", without cost, to our first time skaters (small fitting skaters ages 4-6) and (large fitting skaters ages 6-8). This program will help new skaters settle into the hockey scene, without Mom and Dad spending hundreds of dollars on equipment. OneGoal's vision, as is KAHA's, is to give families one more reason to play hockey! From there, the fun and camaraderie of the game itself can turn first-timers into life-timers! (www.onegoal.com). Here's how it works:

1. Skater must be a new to the hockey program, fitting into the sizes below.
2. All registration forms must be submitted with fee paid in full.
3. Parent/Guardian must be at rink on a defined date to fit equipment to skater.
4. Parent/Guardian must write a check to KAHA in the amount of \$75. This is a damage/replacement guarantee. Check will be voided if equipment is returned in acceptable condition and if everything is returned.
5. First 18 new skaters to attend equipment fitting day will be issued "loan out" equipment.
6. Parent/guardian will have option of canceling registration if equipment is not available.
